

Rule for Conducting the Student University Scientific Conference at BSU

Form No. 1 - Structure of the Scientific Paper

Full title of the scientific paper presented for participation in the BSU Student Scientific Conference	
Name of the conference section	
Name and surname of the paper's author	
Name and surname of the 2nd author of the paper (if it is a joint paper)	
Structural unit of the higher education institution where the paper's author studies (BSU Faculty / BSU Center for Professional Program Management and Continuing Education)	
Name of the other educational institution, if the author of the presented paper is a student of another HEI	
Name of the BSU higher/vocational educational program (where the paper's author studies)	
Level of higher education (Bachelor's/Master's/Single-cycle/Integrated Bachelor's-Master's/Doctoral) / Level of vocational program	
Phone number of the paper's author	
Email of the paper's author	
Name, surname of the scientific supervisor of the paper, position/status held at BSU (BSU academic/scientific/invited teacher/vocational education teacher/BSU emeritus/BSU doctoral student)	

Formatting Parameters for Paper Information

- a) The title of the scientific paper should be written in the middle (font size - 16) (the word "Topic" should not be added to it, nor should it be put in quotation marks).
- b) Below the title of the paper, on the lower right side, the first and last name of the author(s) of the paper should be written (font size - 12).
- c) Below the first and last name of the author(s) of the paper, on the right side, the name of the university, faculty, and program should be written with the indication of the level (font size - 10).
- d) Below the name of the university, faculty, and program, on the right side, contact information should be written (font size - 10).
- e) Below the contact information, on the right side, the name, surname, academic degree, and academic position held by the scientific supervisor of the paper should be written (in the case of an academic person from another university, the name of that university) (font size - 10).
- f) Page numbering starts from the title page, using Arabic numerals (1).

Abstract

The abstract should reflect the theme and research question of the scientific paper, research method, goal(s), main findings, conclusions, and others. The length of the abstract should not exceed 200 words.

Keywords: _____ , _____ , _____ , _____ (no more than 4 words).

Introduction

The introduction is a general overview of the main issues of the scientific paper, where the relevance of the topic, set goals, objectives, and other aspects should be clearly outlined based on the specifics of the research.

Main Body

In this part of the scientific paper, the main issues and themes should be expanded upon. The main body may be divided into chapters and subchapters. Visual aids (tables, graphs, pictures, and others) may be presented in the main body, however, it is preferable in a small amount.

Conclusion

The concluding part of the scientific paper should summarize the previously raised and presented issues, and determine the obstacles encountered during the research process and new opinions/recommendations.

List of Used Literature / Bibliography

A list of used literature should be attached at the end of the scientific paper, where the sources used in the paper will be presented.

General Text Formatting Requirements

- Text must be typed on standard A4 size paper.
- Font type - Sylfaen; Text font size - 12.
- Line spacing - 1.5 lines.
- Margins: left - 3 cm, right - 1.5 cm, top - 2.5 cm, bottom - 2.5 cm.
- Length: 5 to 10 pages.
