TO PARTICIPATE IN THE WORK OF THE CONFERENCE one should submit:

- The application (Appendix 1).
- The electronic version of the report (E-mail: imd@nure.ua) in one of the working languages (English, Russian, Ukrainian) formed according to the requirements and the attached example (Appendix 2).
- The statement of expert evaluation (for employees of KNURE)

SUBMISSION GUIDELINES:

- The volume of the report should be **2-4 full pages** (**A4** size paper), Microsoft Word.
- Margins 30 mm; indention 1 cm.
- The set: Times New Roman, 11 points, one interval between lines.
- Summary in English (up to 10 15 lines).
 - The text of the manuscript should be structured and it should contain all *main parts typical for description of the scientific investigation:* **introduction** (it should represent the *urgency* of the problem and state the *objectives* and *problems* of the research); the **essential part** (it should contain the presentation of the main material of this research with description of the idea, method and substantiation of the obtained scientific results); **conclusions** (they should present results of the research, their *scientific novelty* and *practical significance*, comparison with the world analogues, prospects); **references** (up to 5 items).

- Formulae, symbols, variables in the text should be typed as the Microsoft Equation objects.
- Figures and tables should be clear, compact. Redactors: CorelDraw, Table Editor, Microsoft Excel.
- Texts of the reports will be published as authors presented them without editing.

The order of the material arrangement:

TITLE OF THE REPORT (capital letters, bold, in the middle of the line).

The next line – the author's name, initials (small letters, in the middle of the line).

The next line – the complete title of the organization (small letters, in the middle of the line).

The next line – the mail address, telephone number, E-mail of the organizaion or of the authors.

The next line - the summary in English (up to 10-15 lines). The text of the report should be printed in an interval, indent a line.

Appendix 1
